

## Job Description for Dance Teacher (Jazz, Tap, ISTD Modern)

Main duties and responsibilities:	<ul> <li>To teach and assess Jazz, Tap, ISTD Modern and Tap across the school under the direction of the Head of Dance.</li> <li>To create dance items for a range of performances that might include the annual Dance Show, BTEC Musicals and the Junior Musical Theatre sharing.</li> <li>To supervise the use and care of rooms assigned to Dance, adhering to relevant Health and Safety regulations at all times.</li> <li>Teach ISTD syllabus as well as free work classes as directed by the Head of Dance.</li> </ul>
